

Significant correspondence and Clerk update for January 2026 meeting

- Made regular checks for planning applications, correspondence, road closures etc. relevant to ECC.
- Updated website with planning information received.

- Contacted individual re grass cutting – clarified areas cut, sent payment for 2025.
- Reported white lines at Red Roses junction need refreshing. FS-Case-746094484
- Reported roadside ditches in Marros and surrounding area not cleared for months – need doing urgently. FS-Case-746095641. Informed done 5-9-25. Reported again: I reported concern about the blocked ditches all along this road through Marros back in early September - your reference FS-Case-746095641. In the recent rainfall water has still been flooding out onto and across the main road, so any clearing that was done is not sufficient. These ditches have not been cleared for many months and desperately need a thorough clean out so that water can flow from the highway into them. Re-reported – ref FS-Case-755493522 8-10-25
- The drains and gulleys have not been cleared or cleared frequently enough in this area so the ditches are clogged and full, and the recent rain meant the road was flooded. This applies throughout this road through Marros. I have previously reported it under FS-Case-746095641 and FS-Case-755493522 and local residents have not seen any improvement. Plus drain marker – reported 3-12-25 FS-Case-770683388 to west of church junction, FS-Case-770684071 to east. Reported 3-12-25 – informed it has been passed to Highways on 11-12-25
- There has been flooding into private property several times in the last month or so of rain, possibly because the drains have not been kept clear of leaves and other debris. All the drains from the crossroads towards Pendine past Waun Wen, Sunrise etc down to Fernleigh need checking and clearing thoroughly, please. Water also has been pooling in the known-about road dip outside Fernleigh FS-Case-770927486 reported 4-12-25.
