

EGLWYSCUMMIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL

MINUTES OF MEETING 3rd March 2026

Meeting held at the Red Roses Community Centre: 7.35pm - 8.10pm

1. **Present:** Cllrs C. Mitchell (chair), H. Owen, A Morris, S. Beynon, S. Wilson and the Clerk.
2. **Apologies:** There were apologies received from Cllrs V. Thomas, J. James and County Cllr J. Tremlett.
3. **Declarations of personal interest.** No interests were declared.
4. **Questions** from members of the public. One issue had been raised which was covered in the provided County Councillor's report and Clerk report. No members of the public were present.
5. **To sign as correct the minutes** of the Council meeting held on 3rd February 2026. They were agreed as correct by those present, so were duly signed.
6. **County Councillor's report.** Cllr Tremlett had provided a report stating she was chasing up on what was happening with the old Tremolet School and would report back. She also reported that some ditch work had been done in Marros to deal with the road flooding, but more was planned.
7. **Matters considered:**

Grass cutting contract. The Clerk reported that no applications had been received. The situation was discussed and it was agreed to confirm that Councillors would be covered to do the work voluntarily (the Clerk would check the insurance) and if that was allowed, undertake the cutting either by strimmer or borrowed lawn mower. The Clerk would also ascertain whether non-Council volunteers would be covered for the work under the Council's insurance.

Audit Wales conclusion of 2024-25 audit. The audit had been completed, with an 'unqualified' opinion i.e. no concerns regarding the provided information. The auditor highlighted that no community consultation had been done. It was agreed to consult on views about local transport.

- 8 **Significant correspondence** received or sent and Clerk's report. The Clerk updated the meeting on activity during the last month. This included information received that morning after queries about the roadside ditches at Marros - the further work was within the Public Rights of Way team's responsibility area. She also stated that the query on the caravan in Marros had been passed to planning and acknowledged by them so CCC investigations were proceeding. The Clerk had reported the stop sign at Red Roses crossroads as hidden in the hedge – this had been passed to the landowner, and the hedge had been cut the day of the meeting.

PL/10424. Electricity notification. Land north of A466, Whitland. Registration date 2-2-2026. The Council had no objections. **Application decision – no objection made 27-2-26.**

PL/10134. Garden Pavilion - immediate family and extended members residing on site to congregate and dine together in the shared garden. Barn Owls, Pendine, SA33 4PW. Consultation period open 19-11-2025. **Application granted 9-2-2026.**

PL/10191. Siting of two glamping pods with toilets/shower and associated parking. Cringa Mawr, Whitland. SA34 0LT. Application received 3-12-2025. **Application full granted 13-2-2026.**
