MINUTES OF MEETING 7th April 2026

Meeting held at the Red Roses Community Centre: 7.30pm – 7.55pm

1. **Present:** Cllrs C. Mitchell (chair), H. Owen, A Morris, J. James, S. Beynon, S. Wilson and the Clerk.
2. **Apologies:** There were apologies received from Cllr V. Thomas.
3. **Declarations of personal interest.** No interests were declared.
4. **Questions** from members of the public. No members of the public were present, no questions had been raised by correspondence for the Council.
5. **To sign as correct the minutes** of the Council meeting held on 3rd March 2026. They were agreed as correct by those present, so were duly signed.
6. **County Councillor's report.** Cllr Tremlett was absent from the meeting and had not provided as report.
7. **Matters considered:**

Morfa Bychan proposed PSPO. The Clerk reported CCC had notified her that, since the land affected by anti-social behaviour lies within National Trust owned and managed land, CCC had decided that it was not their responsibility to instigate a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO) for it – that was up to the National Trust to organize.

- 8 **Significant correspondence** received or sent and Clerk's report. The Clerk updated the meeting on activity during the last month. CCC had done further work on the ditch clearing in Marros, and would investigate the status of a footpath (a query raised by a resident with them) when resources permitted. On the Marros caravan additional information was provided in the meeting which she would pass on to CCC. She had opened a social media consultation on local bus transport services as requested by Councillors in the last meeting, but there was a very low response rate as yet.

No planning applications or decisions had been reported for the Community Council area since the last meeting.

Concern was also raised about the white lining in Red Roses village – the Clerk would again raise this with CCC.

It was stated that the bingo on 28th March had been successful. The next one would be on 25th April in Red Roses Hall.
