- Chased lack of response regarding Tremoilet School. Discovered responsibility has passed from CCC to Church in Wales. Continuing to seek further information.
- Marros ditches/gulleys 746095641 reported 5-9-25; repeated 8-1-25 755493522; repeated 3-12-25 770683388 passed to gulley cleansing 8-1-26
- Marros ditches/gulleys plus ditch marker 770684071 reported 3-12-25 – passed to Highways 11-12-25 FS-Case-791654719 reported with images of clogged ditches 28-1-26. Stated by CCC as resolved on 30-1-26.
- Query raised in early March by Marros resident regarding ditch clearance and status of a route – informed after consideration by CCC that it is a footpath – investigation into whether a higher status will be done when resources permit. Ditches will be inspected and remedial work undertaken if needed.
- Red Roses drains clogged reference 770927486 reported 4-12-25.
- A survey on Facebook asking about local residents' views on bus services and availability had been launched in early March to gather opinions for Councillors' information.
- Audit Wales provided listing of documents and information required for full 2025-26 audit late March – Clerk started working on collating information for them.
